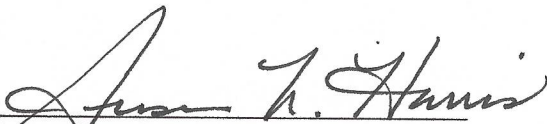

24 Nation nor any other party has filed a statement that specifically identifies any deficiencies in
25 water attributes for water claims listed in the expert reports or disclosure statements.
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1 Accordingly, the Hopi Tribe and the United States have no obligation to file a Response to a
2 Statement.
