General Explanation

This order opens a case to determine rights to use water on land owned by the individuals and entities listed in Attachment E to this order. The first step in this case is an initial conference with the Court, scheduled for **April 3, 2024, at 10:00 a.m.** to determine if landowners are interested in pursuing potential water rights. Interested Parties **MUST** attend the scheduled initial conference if they plan to pursue potential water rights. Failure to appear at the initial conference

1 could result in the dismissal of the case and the loss of water rights associated with the properties.

2 In this case, Joseph Pones filed Statement of Claimant (“SOC”) 39-6365 on July 1, 1980,
3 to assert claims to use water on land in Section 17 Township 16 South, Range 20 East.

4 The first step in this case will be an initial conference, where landowners will state
5 whether they intend to pursue water rights.

10 **Details of the Case**

11 On July 1, 1980, Joseph Pones filed Statement of Claimant (“SOC”) 39-6365, which
12 claimed rights to use groundwater for domestic and irrigation purposes.

13 The Arizona Department of Water Resources (“ADWR”) investigated the claims made
14 by Joseph Pones (“Claimant”) and prepared Watershed File Report No. 112-14-DDC-001
15 (“WFR”), published in the Final San Pedro Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991) (“San
16 Pedro HSR”). The WFR recorded that a well in SESENE Section 17 Township 16 South, Range
17 20 East was being used for domestic and irrigation purposes. The WFR also recorded that surface
18 water was being used for stockpond purposes. ADWR also published a map of the area
19 investigated, denoted by “(1).” A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment B, and a copy of
20 the map is attached as Attachment C.

21 After ADWR issued the WFR, objections were filed to the findings made in the WFR by
22 the United States, ASARCO, the Gila River Indian Community, San Carlos Apache Tribe, Tonto
23 Apache Tribe, the Yavapai-Apache Tribe, the Camp Verde Reservation, the Salt River Project,
24 and Chester C. Antonick.
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1 **Claimant and Landowners**

2 The WFR lists Chester C. Antonick as the owner of the property investigated. According
3 to maps obtained from the Navajo County Assessor (“Assessor”), the land investigated appears
4 to comprise the tax parcels listed in Attachment E.

5 A map showing the relevant tax parcels, the San Pedro River subflow zone, and the
6 approximate location of the well supplying the domestic and irrigation uses detailed in the WFR
7 is attached as Attachment D.

8 The public records of the Arizona Department of Water Resources do not contain any
9 assignments of the SOC listed in the WFR, and the current landowners do not appear to have
10 filed any additional SOCs.

11 To pursue water rights, a property owner must file a Statement of Claimant and present
12 to the Court evidence of the existence of a water right on their property. This evidence may
13 include the WFR. If either the property owner proves to the Court the existence of water rights
14 on their property or enters into a valid settlement approved by the Court, the Court will recognize
15 enforceable water rights in a “Final Decree.” Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-257(B).

16 This is an Order from the Court. All parties must comply with the following instructions.
17 The failure to obey this, or any, court order may result in the dismissal of this case and the loss
18 of any potential water rights associated with the properties mentioned in this Order. If you have
19 questions regarding this order or any of the attachments, please contact the General Stream
20 Adjudication, Office of the Special Water Master, at (602) 372-4115. Please note that staff can
21 only answer administrative questions and cannot provide legal advice.

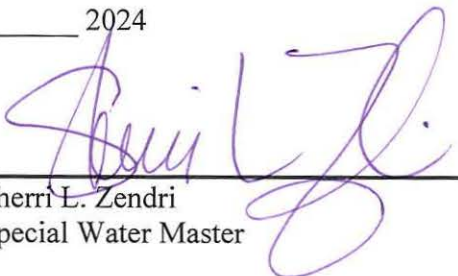
22 **IT IS ORDERED:**

- 23 1. Case Initiation. This contested case shall be known as *In re Chester C.*
24 *Antonick*, and it will resolve claims to appropriable water asserted in Statement of
25 Claimant 39-6365 and objections that were filed to Watershed File Report No. 112-
26 14-DDC-001.

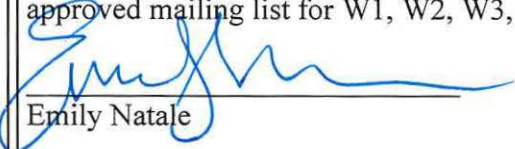
- 1 2. Initial Conference. An initial conference shall be held on **April 3, 2024 at 10:00**
2 **a.m.** to determine whether current landowners intend to pursue claims for water
3 rights. The conference will be held using the Court Connect program. Instructions
4 for Court Connect are attached as Attachment G. If you receive this order by email,
5 click on the red box “Join Court Connect Hearing” on the attached instructions to
6 make an appearance. If you do not receive this order by email, log into the Court
7 Connect program on the internet by typing <https://tinyurl.com/specialwatermaster>. If
8 you do not have access to the internet, you may attend telephonically using the
9 telephone number and access code included in the instructions for Court Connect.
- 10 3. Parties. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimant, the current landowners,
11 and any party who filed an objection to the Watershed File Report. The objectors in
12 this case are the United States, ASARCO, the Gila River Indian Community, San
13 Carlos Apache Tribe, Tonto Apache Tribe, the Yavapai-Apache Tribe, the Camp
14 Verde Reservation, the Salt River Project, and Chester C. Antonick
- 15 4. Objections. Copies of the objection filed to WFR No. 112-14-DDC-001 can be found
16 under the case number W1-11-1508 on the following website:

24 Court-approved mailing list.

26 Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the
27 Court-approved mailing list.

- 1 C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file
2 a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be
3 automatically added to the Court-approved mailing list.

ATTACHMENT A

General Background on the Water Rights Determination Process in Arizona

A general stream adjudication is a judicial proceeding to determine the quantity and priority of all water rights in a river system. Arizona is undertaking general stream adjudications of both the Gila River and the Little Colorado River systems. A river system includes surface water flowing “in streams or other natural channels”, groundwater sufficiently connected to that surface water, and water subject to claims by the federal government. Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-251(7). Recognizing and respecting water rights and the priority of such rights is important in Arizona where times of drought or water scarcity can occur.

All cases begin with the filing of a “Statement of Claimant,” (“SOC”) in which a property owner makes a claim for a right to use surface water on their property. Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-254(A). This person is the “claimant.” The SOC contains, among other characteristics, a description of the source and quantity of the water used, the location of use, the location from which the water was diverted, and the date when the water was first put to use. *Id.* § 45-254(C).

After the property owner files the SOC, the Arizona Department of Water Resources (“ADWR”) prepares a “Watershed File Report,” (“WFR”) in which ADWR investigates the claims in the SOC and recommends water rights associated with the property. *Id.* § 45-256(B). ADWR compiles all WFRs for a watershed into a comprehensive Hydrographic Survey Report (“HSR”) and publishes the report for public review and comment. In response, other claimants in the Adjudication may file “objections” disputing the information or recommendations in the WFR. The individuals who file objections are called “objectors.”

This “contested case”, one of thousands in the Gila River System, will evaluate claims asserted in specific Statements of Claimant while considering objections to the WFR that reported ADWR’s initial inspection of those claims.

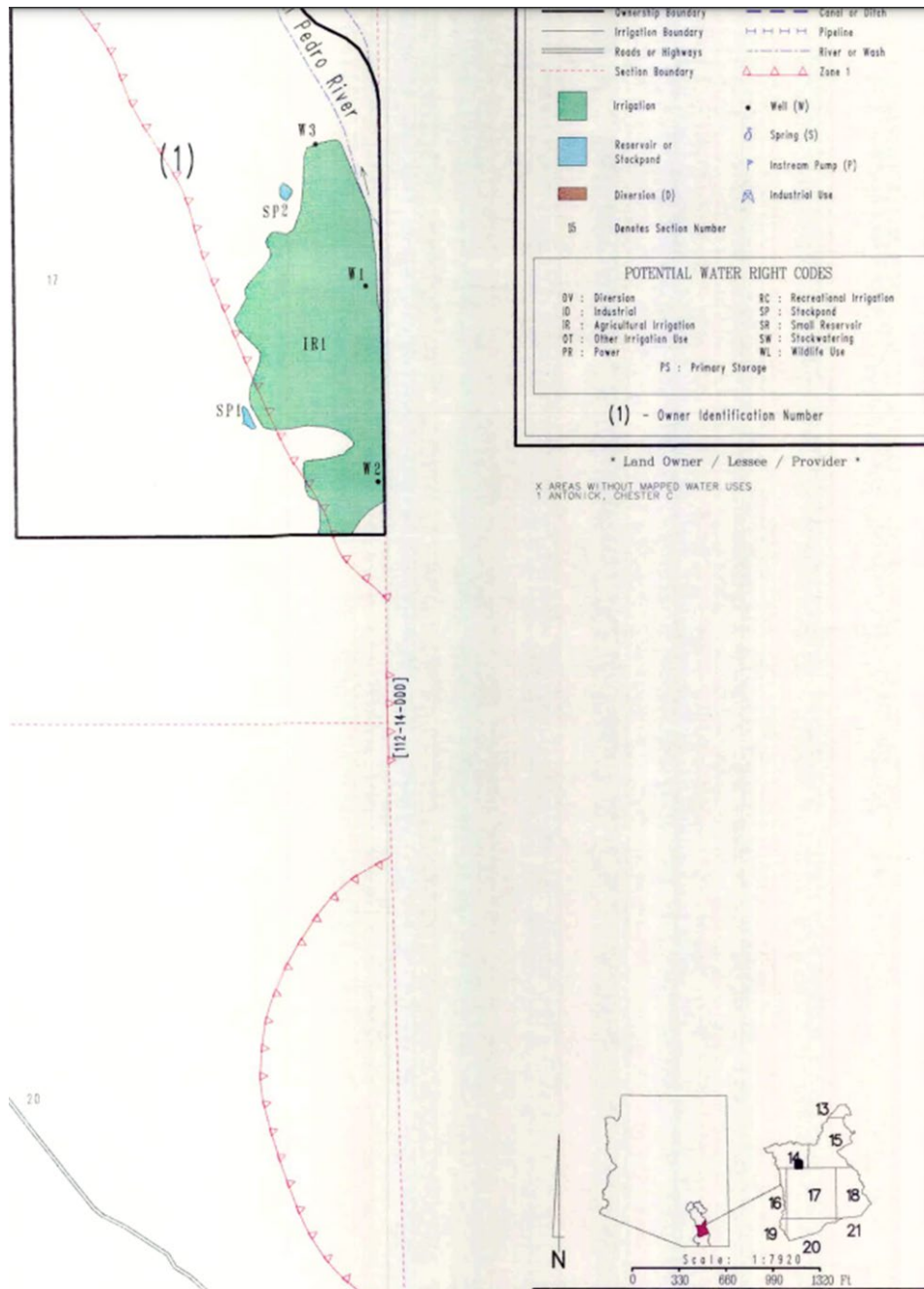
